Post-Op Instructions for Nipple Areolar Reconstruction

- Keep all breast dressings in place until we see you at your 1st follow-up appointment, usually 5-7 days after surgery.
- We have several options for dressings that we might select for you, based on any skin sensitivities or additional procedures we might be performing during your surgery:
 - 1. If you wake up with <u>large</u>, <u>clear plastic dressings over bulky gauze pads</u>: Showers are **OK** to take, as long as you do not get water trapped beneath the dressing which will soak the gauze pads. Call us if this happens to change the dressing.
 - 2. If you wake up with <u>yellow pressure dressings</u> (they look like gift-wrapped little packages): You may **NOT** take a shower... we do not want these to get wet. We will remove these dressings at your first post-op appointment, and then you may shower.
- We will give you nipple protectors at your 1st post-op appointment to wear under a bra. You will wear these for an additional 2-3 weeks.
- We will remove any visible stitches from your nipple grafts at your 2nd post-op visit.
- If your healing skin grafts are dry and flaky, you may apply a light layer of Aquaphor daily, as needed, unless directed otherwise.
- Do not submerge your breasts in water (ex. Bathtub, pool, hot tub) until the nipple grafts have completely healed. We recommend waiting 4-6 weeks post-operatively.
- You may pursue nipple tattooing ~2-3 months after your nipples have healed. We will refer you to professional medical tattoo specialists.
